EXCEL CERTIFICATE (\$169.50)

EXCEL is a practical, flexible, distance education program that provides an opportunity to acquire and develop core skills in all areas of public library service. Students can complete individual courses based on interest or can choose to pursue the EXCEL Certificate.

EXCEL is specifically designed for public library staff or volunteers who have little or no formal library training. To obtain the EXCEL Certificate, learners must successfully complete ten (10) EXCEL courses, including six (6) mandatory courses, within five years.
